If it please the Council to consider:

1. On behalf of the Chamber of Commerce:
 - a. To join with us in wishing to see the improvement of the access to Hayle Harbour.
 - b. To seek funding to improve the channel. This might be obtained through external public sources particularly the EU, and obtained through Convergence.

2. On behalf of Save Our Sands (SOS):
 - a. To share our concerns about the possible environmental impact of tin reclamation such as proposed by Marine Minerals in St Ives Bay, but to join us in deferring a decision on their proposals until we, and they, know what it is that is being proposed.
 - b. To join with us in a preliminary consideration of the implications for the Copperhouse Pool of the Environment Agency report:
